- **a.** Department Head Reports: Brekke (water) no updates, Larson (sewer) no updates, Stoulil (park & rec) discussed 9 (b) and 9 (d) on the agenda. Mitchell (buildings) no updates, Burton (streets) no updates.
- b. Councilman Stoulil stated that the Golf Course is looking for a new treasurer. No action was taken.
- **c.** Councilman Brekke asked the council if a donation could be given to the Fire Dept. to defray the cost of the new concrete around the flagpole. Larson made a motion and Stoulil seconded to give a donation of \$5,000 to the Fire Dept. No further discussion. Three ayes and Burton and Mitchell abstained...MC
- **d.** As for the matter of putting more sprinkler heads in the park, nothing was decided at this time.
- e. Larson made a motion and Burton seconded to adopt and pass SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 2024-01...an Ordinance amending chapter 106, §106.08(1)(A)(B) of the Sloan Municipal Code by Increasing the Collection and Disposal of Solid Waste Fees. No further discussion. All ayes...MC

- f. Stoulil made a motion and Mitchell seconded to entertain a motion to waive 3rd reading and adopt FINAL reading of ORDINANCE 2024-01 PER IOWA CODE 380.3. No further discussion. All ayes...MC Roll Call Vote: Stoulil (Yes), Mitchell (Yes), Brekke (Yes), Burton (Yes), Larson (Yes)
- **g.** The council discussed amending Ordinance Chapter 155, section 155.07 by adding an additional paragraph setting a fee for the planning and zoning administrator's fee for building permits. The amended Ordinance will be presented in December.

# 10. Updates from City Clerk:

- **a.** The city received the MRHD Grant for \$25,000 and the Clerk has applied for the ICAP Grant for \$1,000. Both will be used towards the new lighting around the sidewalk in the City Park.
- **b.** As for the matter of a refund on a building permit, it failed for lack of motion.
- **c.** The clerk informed the council that the city may have to change accounting software next year. More discussion will take place in a few months.
